Luncheon will be followed by a talk by Dr. Sanford Lakoff on the subject of *"Iran, Israel and the United States: Challenges, Dangers and Policy Options"*.

Dr. Lakoff is Dickinson Professor of Political Science Emeritus at University of California San Diego. He has authored or edited thirteen books including his most recent *"Strategic Defense in the Nuclear Age"* published in 2007. He is a native of New Jersey, earned his B. A. at Brandeis University in 1953 and received his Ph.D. from Harvard University in 1959 along with awards including a Harvard Foundation Fellowship and the Bowdoin Prize. He has lectured at many universities, presented academic papers in the U. S., Canada, and Europe and spoken on public issues in community forums and on radio and television. His Op Ed articles have appeared in the San Diego Union Tribune, the Los Angeles Times and other newspapers in the U. S. and Canada.

June 04: Dr. Rosco Williamson will discuss "**The Dangers of New Money: Development, Democratization, and the Return of Civil War.**" Dr. Williamson is Professor of Political Science at Point Loma Nazarene University. He holds a Ph.D in Political Science from UCSD and an M.A. in History from San Diego State University. He will analyze the currently dominant position at the World Bank, the UN, and the US government--that economic development is the best means to prevent a country from returning to civil war.

June 18: Dr. Don Gragg, M.D. will apply his medical knowledge to the topic "**Pandemic Influenza: The Swine Flu Story**". Will Swine Flu 2009 be a replay of the 1976 Swine Flu fiasco, or will we see a real pandemic, or something in between? This will be an update to a very informative talk that Don gave us a few years ago regarding pandemic influenza. He is a past president of the San Diego World Affairs Council and of the RB Continuing Education Center.

June 25: Author and biologist, Dr. Judith Hand, under the title "**No More War**" will present a biological and anthropological perspective on male/female differences with respect to conflict. She will go on to explain what will be required of us, men and women as full partners, if we are to convert the dream of a future without war into a reality.
